The project offers the chance for participants to take part in school taster workshops, half term projects and weekly dance classes at Swindon Dance, perform in local platforms and work with a professional dance company. STAGE 1 - Taster Dance Workshops in your School!

To kick start the project we are offering YOUR pupils and students the chance to experience and take part in a fun, inspiring and creative dance workshop led by a professional dance teacher. You can book a 45 minutes workshop for up to 15 students or book in a half day workshop programme for up to 45 students (half day - 3 x 45mins workshop). Workshops on offer throughout October so book your workshop/s today and let your students and pupils have some fun! Cost: 45mins workshop £20 / half day £50

Participants who took part in the taster workshop and are interested in continuing their dance experience can join in an exciting half term project at Swindon Dance taking place over 3 days.
