

APPENDIX B

SWINDON DANCE THEATRE TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION (updated March 2019)

PERFORMANCE SPACE

- A large vaulted room painted neutral grey with 97 seats in a single rake.
- The performance space is approx 7m (23') wide by 6m (20') deep.
- Sprung wooden floor with a choice of black or grey dance vinyl (advance notice required).
- White cyc is hung behind black tabs on a track on the upstage lighting truss. 3 black legs hang on each side as token masking (there is no wing space). NB Cyc cannot be removed.
- The Lighting Grid is a ground supported Trillite truss structure, 4.5m (15') high (see plan for detail and leg positions).
- 2 dressing rooms (max capacity: 12 performers), stage right, each with a shower & toilet.

LIGHTING

There are 72 x channels of Strand LD90 - 10A dimming, with socket outlets as follows:

42 outlets in the grid over the stage

24 outlets for side light (12 per side)

6 outlets on a F.O.H bar

N.B: House Lights use one channel of dimming. There is a maximum loading of 8kw per phase (protected by MCB's in the control room). Please take this into consideration when drawing your lighting plan (plan showing outlet distribution & phasing available on request).

Control: 1 x ETC Express 24/48, with remote focus unit.

5 x Prelude 40° 650 w Profile (fixed focus)

PAR 6 x Source Four PAR 575 w.
4 x Source Four PARNEL 575w.
10 x PAR 64 Cans all with CP88 500w. lamps

Flood 4 x Coda 3 cell cyc flood (3 x 500 w)

Stands: 6 x 2m sidelight booms with 3 boom arms on each
5 x Bench Base (low) stands

SOUND

Sound is controlled from the Control Room (windows are removable)

TECHNICAL STAFF

One technician is provided for get-in, show cover and get-out. Additional technical help may be arranged, if required, by prior agreement with Swindon Dance's Executive Director.

ACCESS

We have a lift suitable for smaller props/equipment (weight load: 340 kilos). Please seek advice in advance for larger items, e.g.set/props.

PRE-RIGGING

Can be arranged by prior agreement with the Operations Manager. This needs to be agreed well in advance. Plans to reach us at the latest, 1 week prior to pre-rig day. On pre-rigging days, the theatre space may only be available between 9am and 4pm. Please ensure times are confirmed with Swindon Dance's Operations Manager in advance.

FIRE & SAFETY

The DSR stage access door and the backstage corridor are a fire exit and must be kept clear of obstructions at all times.

All scenery must be flame-proofed, and is liable to testing by ourselves.

The use of pyrotechnics, smoke, naked flame etc. must be notified in writing to us at least 14 days before the performance to allow for any necessary arrangements including risk assessment by Swindon Dance.

Ladders not to be used without a second technician or member of Swindon Dance staff available to support you.
