

HOLLY OSMOND PRIMARY STEPS TEACHER

Born in Harrogate, North Yorkshire, Holly trained locally from an early age. She was selected as an RAD York Scholar at the age of 13, later becoming a Senior Associate of The Royal Ballet School.

Holly continued her training vocationally, embarking on a 3-year diploma course at London Studio Centre. This led to a varied career in the world of dance, musical theatre, and acting, where she performed in a large variety of shows including regional theatre, several national tours, and The West End. Alongside performing, Holly taught ballet on a freelance basis in London for many years.

She is an Assistant Dance Artist for English National Ballet's Dance for Parkinson's programme in Oxford, and volunteers with dance charity, Dance Creative.

Holly is currently in her second year on The Royal Ballet School's Diploma of Dance Teaching course.
